**WHO IS ELIGIBLE?** Any student whose career objective is broadcast journalism and who currently is studying at sophomore level or above at an accredited Southern California college or university.

**WHAT ARE THE RTNA/JIM ZAILLIAN MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP, THE RTNA/JERRY DUNPHY MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP, THE RTNA/HAL FISHMAN MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS, AND THE RTNA/CAROL BREASHEARS MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS?** The Radio and Television News Association of Southern California (RTNA) is the Southland's leading organization for broadcast journalists. One scholarship is named in honor of the late Jim Zaillian, who served as KNX news director for ten years. Zaillian was an active member of RTNA and had a special interest in the education of broadcast journalism students. Other scholarships are named in honor of legendary anchors Jerry Dunphy (KCBS/KCAL, KABC) and Hal Fishman (KTLA) and long-time broadcast journalist and former RTNA President Carol Breshears. Breshears was the first female news director in the Los Angeles market. Winners will receive their scholarship awards at the **Golden Mike Awards Dinner** in the Spring of 2023.
